Are you aware of the S106 funding from Tesco? Under S106 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990, as amended, contributions can be sought from developers towards the costs of providing community and social infrastructure, the need for which has arisen as a result of a new development taking place. This funding is commonly known as 'Section 106' although Tesco sold the land they are happy for the funding to be used for Stirchley High Street. The funding is available until 2023 if unused it will be refunded to Tesco. We would like to see benefits for Stirchley sooner rather than later. After nearly 20 years of disruption and blight, we would like to see our community having the opportunity to benefit from the Commonwealth Games July 2022. We would like to see a cleaner, greener, safer high street.
